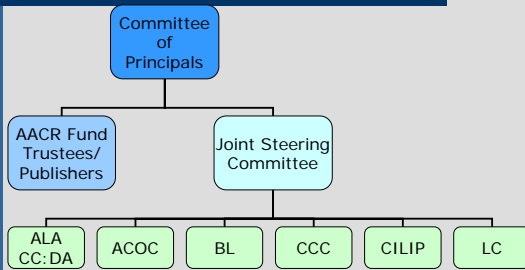

Committee of Principals – responsible for AACR

- Added National Library of Australia to Committee of Principals (Apr 07)
 - 4 directors from national libraries (LC, BL, LAC, Australia)
 - 3 national associations (ALA, CLA, CILIP)

RDA and CoP

4 national libraries to implement RDA in 2009 (Oct 07)

- Library of Congress
- British Library
- Library & Archives of Canada
- National Library of Australia

RDA and JSC

- JSC name changed (Apr 07)
 - To: Joint Steering Committee for the Development of RDA
 - From: Joint Steering Committee for the Revision of AACR
- ALA representative on JSC changed (07)
 - To: John Attig
 - From: Jennifer Bowen

RDA and JSC

- Hired RDA Editor – Tom Delsey (04)
- Hired RDA Project Manager - Marjorie Bloss (Oct 05)
- Selected RDA publisher (07)– to be announced

RDA and JSC

- New approach / new standard needed
- Changed name from AACR3 to RDA (Apr 05)
- Opened to other stakeholders (Apr 05)
- Prospectus released (Jul 05)
- Aligned with FRBR and FRAD

RDA and Other Stakeholders

- International- International Standard Bibliographic Description (ISBD(G))
- Archives – Describing Archives: A Content Standard (DACS)
- Museum – Cataloging Cultural Objects (CCO)

- Issued final report (Aug 06)
- Outcome: Using elements: Mode of Issuance, Media type, Carrier type and Content type

RDA and Dublin Core (DC)

- Based on DCMI Abstract Model
- Data Model meeting (May 07)
- DC is developing a DC AP
- JSC develop RDA AP

RDA and MARC21

- Coordinating work with USMARC Advisory Committee
- Coordinating work with MARBI (ALA/ALCTS)
- MARC>RDA mapping

- Changed from 3 parts (I,II,III) to 2 parts (A - Description,B - Access Pt Control)(Apr 06)
- Part A, chs 1-2, 4-5 (Dec 05)
- Part A, ch 3 rev (Mar 07)
- Part A, chs 6-7 (Jun 07)
- Changed A/B to two groups; ten sections (Oct 07)
- Former Part B (Access Pt Control) review Dec 07
- First release in 2009
